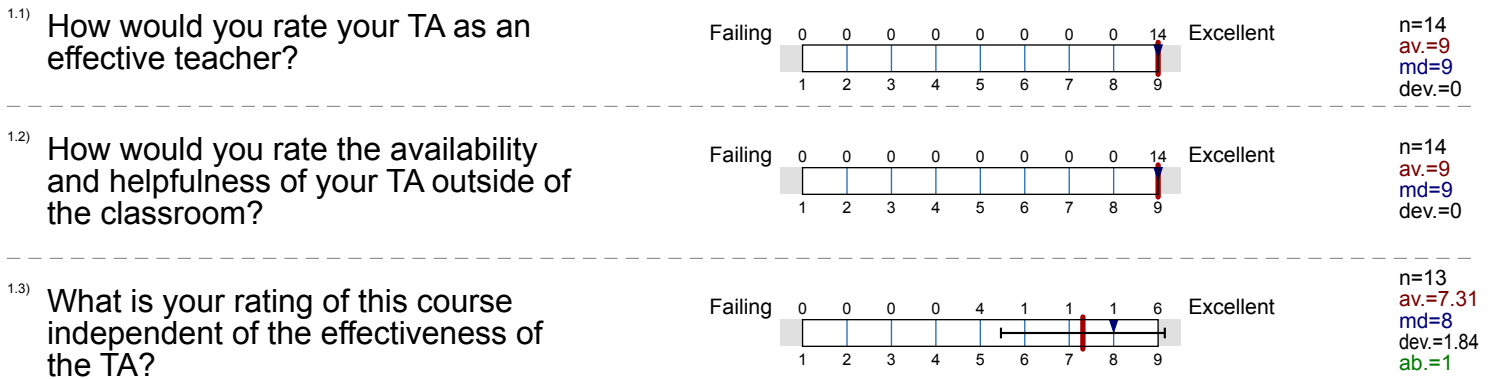

It would be helpful to condense or pace the information, however, so that everything that was outlined/anticipated to be covered can be covered in the allotted time (or have a slightly longer discussion section would be fine too, since the teaching style is engaging enough. I have some other sessions that are a full hour instead of 50 minutes and it seemed like this section could have used those extra 10 minutes.
 - My TA was extremely helpful in helping us understand the course material. There were a few times during the course of the quarter when topics would not be made very clear in lecture, but during discussion section our TA would cover these topics again in a understandable manner. He was also very available for helping students outside of class time with issues, and provided practice problems to help us learn.
